Feature of the Month

We were busy during March trying to ignore that winter will just not give up. All that coding has delivered some cool new enhancements for Dynamics GP that you can share with your customers.

GP PowerPack

- Alerts: The popular Alerts have been added to Inventory Transactions and Transfers, Apply Sales Documents, Cash Receipts, Receivables Transactions, Apply Payables Documents, Manual Payment Entry, and Payables Transactions.
- Cash Receipt Report: print a "cash receipt" for your customer. [View a sample.](#)
- AP Templates: Save time by re-using a "template" of a complex AP transaction.
- GPEmail: send simple, text-based email confirmations from SOP

MFG PowerPack

- SmartParts: reduce the errors and irregularities in part numbering through the use of Item Number Masks. Similar to the Serial Number mask in GP, SmartParts supports creating rules which guide users through the process of creating consistent, logical item numbers.

EZImport - NEW!

Have you ever had to bring sales history, in detail, into GP from a legacy system? It can be a complex, time-consuming task.

EZImport provides a set of tables for SOP and POP that mirror the GP tables, but with all columns allowing nulls and with default values. Inside of GP EZImport provides SOP and POP Inquiry windows for viewing the imported data, and new SmartList objects that provide consolidated views of all SOP and POP transactions (GP and EZImport combined).

The nullable columns mean that a direct-to-table import can be created that maps only the data you want to import, without the need to provide data for every field in a GP table. The default values automatically fill a field if no value is provided in the import.

Since an import into the EZImport tables bypasses the SOP or POP tables, the ID fields are not validated against existing master records. For example, EZImport does not require that Customer Numbers, Item Numbers, Vendors, or any other ID-field, exist in GP.

EZImport provides a quick way to retain legacy data for reference and reporting, while dramatically reducing the time needed to get it into GP. Perhaps April 2009 is the time to finally decommission that old server!

Random Branch

Customization. It is not a four letter word.
