Feature of the Month

We added several new features to GP PowerPack last month.

- Alerts: think of this as GP Notes that "git in yer face!" GP Notes are great as long as you look at them. Alerts pop-open and force the user to see them. Attach notes to SOP Documents, Purchase Orders, Items, Customers and Vendors.
- idModifier: sure you could get one of the "modifier" utilities in the Professional Services Tools, but idModifier combines them all into one module for one great price. And its proprietary Dynamic Search can locate the ID fields inside of 3rd Party Products and Custom Code.
- Most Recently Used List: just like the MRU list of recent documents in Word or Excel, MRU for SOP and POP provide quick access to the last documents your worked with.
- Note Locking: want to add a note and keep users from messing with it? If so, Note Locking is the tool for you.
- View Wizard: a special addition for consultants and power users. View Wizard creates a SQL view based on the Dexterity table definition. Why is this cool? It results in a view with readable column names, like ItemNumber, CurrentCost, or PrimaryShipToAddressCode. This tool is really handy for creating tables used for reporting, or in complex queries pulled into SmartList Builder.
