Feature of the Month

In a recent service pack for GP version 9 and version 10, Microsoft removed the ability to edit the PURCH account distributions on PO Receipts and PO Invoices.

There are many customers that needed the ability to edit the PURCH account, especially for non-inventory item purchases. GP PowerPack has a new Tweak that will re-enable the ability to edit the summary distributions, and, it has a new "Default" distribution method where it creates one distribution line per line-item on the Receipt or Invoice (it "un-summarizes").

Random Branch

A simple but effective trouble-shooting tip: copy the entire GP program folder. Now you can edit the SET file, remove 3rd party products, remove VB mods, whatever you want.

We will often start by stripping down the client to a bare-bones install (i.e. just GP, Manufacturing, etc, but no 3rd party products, modified forms, modified reports, and other non-essential components). We then run a test of the troublesome transaction to see if the problem still occurs. If so, we know at that point that there is either a GP problem, or something wrong with the data/database.

When you are finished, just rename the GP folder to GP_test, and rename the Copy of GP to "GP", and you are back to the original configuration.
