Features of the Month

GP PowerPack: We added a new Tweak in January: **Use Item's Default Site**. Instead of pulling the fulfillment Site from the Default Site on Sales Transaction Entry, the Default Site assigned to each item is used.

February saw the addition of **Mass Batch Change**, a utility to quickly change the Batch ID on a large number of unrelated SOP Documents. The query builder window allows building a complex selection criteria using many fields from the Sales Header, User Defined Fields, and Sales Lines.

WASPLink: If you are implementing barcoding, Wasplink is the key to unlock simple barcode printing from inside Dynamics GP. In January we added the ability to print barcodes from a list of items in a SmartList.
