Feature of the Month

Migrating from Horizons Manufacturing to Dynamics GP Manufacturing? We have a tool for that: the Horizons Migration Tool.

The Horizons Migration Tool automatically moves Bills of Material and Routings into GP Manufacturing, and provides several mapping tools that allow you to change ID's in the process.

The tool will handle most of the Horizons data for a typical discreet manufacturer, but there are several features in Horizons that are not compatible with GP.

We will be happy to work with you to build custom migration add-ons if your client has Horizons data that does not have a location in GP Manufacturing.

Random Branch

A question we have been asked several times is: It is possible to track serial/lot numbers on non-serial/lot tracked inventory, or even service-type items or non-inventory items entered in SOP?

A common reason for wanting to do this is that the numbers need to be tracked for recall or warranty purposes, but it is not necessary to track them in inventory, and perhaps it is also too cumbersome to use them during manufacturing.

The SOP Module has a separate table for tracking the serial/lot numbers used on a sales transaction, and this table is what gives SOP the interesting ability

to add serial/lot numbers on-the-fly. In a way, the SOP module "integrates" into Inventory, but since it has its own copy of inventory information, it also has some "stand-alone" characteristics.

This feature in SOP allows us to create a custom "entry" window so a GP user can enter serial/lot numbers directly into the SOP Serial/Lot table. You can then record serial/lot numbers for ANY line item, regardless of its Item Type (or even if it is a non-inventory item). A neat benefit of this approach is that the serial/lot numbers print on the SOP forms without any additional modifications.
